ABOUT THE CO-FOUNDERS

Background: Mfon and Faith Cyrus-David are a beloved couple who committed their lives to Jesus Christ as teenagers. They met and fell in love in 1984 during their undergraduate medical education in the University of Port Harcourt School of Medicine, Port Harcourt, Nigeria. They married in 1990, shortly after their graduation, lived briefly in Nigeria, where they were blessed with three daughters—Idara, Deborah and Joanna. Mfon returned to the United States in 1995, and Faith and their three daughters joined him permanently in 1998. Precious, their youngest daughter was born in 2005. They've known and loved each other for 36 years, being married for 29 of these. Mfon is an expert in Strategic Management and Medical Affairs; while Faith is a Medical Director and the Attending Physician of Geriatrics & Palliative Care and Family Medicine.

Christian Ministry: Mfon has been in active ministry for 35 years, and as a marriage minister for 18 years. He was born again in 1977, and was nurtured through the training programs of various Christian ministries and fellowships, such as the Revival Valley Ministries, Uyo; Nigerian Fellowship of Evangelical Students' (NIFES) Christian Union (i.e. similar to the Chi Alpha Ministry) of the University of Port Harcourt (Vice President), the Joint Campus Christian Fellowship of the University of Port Harcourt (Coordinator), and the NIFES Uyo Subzone, Uyo in Nigeria (Chairman). While in Nigeria, he served as a Church Growth Pastor under the leadership of Reverend Abel Damina, the Bishop of the Power City in Uyo; was also an invited speaker to seminars hosted by various Christian organizations, including the Full Gospel Businessmen International, Uyo Chapter. In 1995, he was formally ordained into the ministry by Archbishop Elijah Mboho, the President of the Goodnews Community International, Nigeria. In response to God's call, he and his Faith serve as Bible teachers, conference speakers, marriage enrichment and deliverance ministers. In 2013, they co-founded the Newfoundland Foundation Inc., Sugar Land, TX. Their mission is to promote Godly living through true worship, to demonstrate His sovereignty through intercessory prayers for individuals or nations, and His unfailing love through Christian outreach programs (especially targeting the medically underserved). By doing these, they would build up the body of Christ unto maturity, as we prepare our world for His return.
